Music, art, architecture, handicrafts – the masterpieces crafted by man are as fascinating as nature itself. Be inspired by ten themed flowerbeds as you walk through the historic town centre.

## FLOWER FLOATS

**FLOATS ADORNED WITH FLOWERS**  
Handcrafted and decorated with thousands of chrysanthemums, fascinating flower floats await Chrysanthema guests again this year along the circular route and in the town hall gardens.

## THEMED FLOWER BEDS

**MUSEUMSPLATZ**  
Chrysanthemum bushes in warm red, orange and yellow bring the **Indian summer** to Lahr. They reflect the colourful autumn leaves of Canadian maple trees in the last few sunny rays of the year. A fascinating play of colours is created, which is also transferred to the soft movement of colourful, dancing ribbons, like leaves in the autumn wind.

**HISTORIC TOWN WALL**  
Featuring musical instruments in bloom, the themed flowerbed along the medieval town wall ties in with the numerous concerts in the **Stadtpark** and the cultural programme in the **Parktheater** theatre.

**STADTMÜHLE**  
Hundreds of chrysanthemum bushes are combined to form a typical **coffee plantation in Costa Rica**. Surrounded by tropical plants and volcanoes typical for the country's landscape, the toucans are particularly popular with tourists. They represent the fascinating colourful bird life in Costa Rica.

**LAMMSTRASSE**  
On Lammstrasse, visitors to the Chrysanthema can expect a **Matisse installation** of chrysanthemums. The 1.50 metre tall sculptures are planted with chrysanthemums.

**URTEILSPLATZ**  
The **Japanese Garden** at Urteilsplatz is dedicated to the Asian roots of the chrysanthemum. A wealth of horticultural expertise comes from the twin town of Kasama, which is known for its century-old tradition of chrysanthemum festivals. This year, a 25-metre long **Chrysanthemum dragon** watches over Urteilsplatz. The ozukuri exhibited here – a special cultivated form of the chrysanthemum – is a special feast for the eyes and the only one of its kind in Europe.

**SONNENPLATZ**  
Masterfully staged by **Europa-Park**, this year's themed flowerbed on Sonnenplatz celebrates a lively, international friendship.

**SCHLOSSERSTRASSE**  
The trainees of Bau- und Gartenbetrieb Lahr present their skills with their own **themed flowerbed!**

**ROSENBRUNNEN**  
Lahr has a long tradition as a city of writing: the flowerbed commemorates the Lahr-born graphic artist and educator Ludwig Sütterlin.

**SCHLOSSPLATZ**  
Schlossplatz is traditionally decorated by our French friends and neighbours. The **Eurodistrict flowerbed** is a floral interpretation of the European anthem. Beethoven's "Ode to Joy" describes the ideal of a society of equal people. The **twin town Dole** serves up a surprise with an extravagantly designed flowerbed to mark the 60th anniversary of the partnership. Dole is located in the heart of Franche-Comté and attracts visitors with its picturesque old town and excellent food. **Erstein and Benfeld** lie only a few kilometres on the other side of the Rhine. The sugar festival in August attracts numerous visitors to Erstein every year.

**STORCHENTURM**  
On the site once home to the palace of the fortified Geroldsecker castle, white, purple and pale pink chrysanthemum bushes adorn the historic square. The flowerbed evokes the ornamental style of a **of a medieval floral border** that can be found embroidered on historical fabrics and as an ornament in letterpress printing.
