

THEMED FLOWER BEDS

MUSEUMSPLATZ

The BGL trainees' flower bed transports you to a colourful hippie flower power world full of energy and imagination. 2,000 bright chrysanthemums, shrill shapes and dancing butterflies create a lively experience. A water feature brings peace to the colourful hustle and bustle. Designed to be accessible, it invites you to immerse yourself, discover and dream. It is also a photo point for great memories.

HISTORIC CITY WALL

The Indian festival of lights, Diwali, is an important Hindu festival celebrated between October and November. It symbolises the victory of light over darkness and of good over evil. It is a custom to place flowers with candles on the Ganges. The colours of this bed reflect the mood: Purple stands for water, yellow for the shining lights.

HISTORIC CITY MILL

"La Pura Vida" – the Costa Rican attitude to life stands for lightness, joy and enjoyment. This bed invites you to linger in a tropical setting: Palm trees, a hammock and bright chrysanthemums in yellow, red, orange, purple and bronze create a warm, lively oasis. A place to let go of the daily grind and enjoy the moment. Various varieties of chrysanthemums are arranged along the passage to Marktplatz square.

LAMMSTRASSE

The lovingly designed flower bed awakens feelings of spring. Between fresh greenery and delicate flowers, an idyllic scene with a picnic in the countryside is created, surrounded by a peaceful sheep pasture. Decorative sheep combine nature and art, while brightly coloured chrysanthemums line the meadow and create a playful, spring-like atmosphere.

URTEILSPLATZ

The Japanese bed takes visitors on a journey through Japan's natural beauty. A curved path leads past stylised islands of white and red chrysanthemums, accompanied by gentle waterfalls and suggestive fields. A large Maneki-Neko beckoning cat greets you as a symbol of good luck.

SONNENPLATZ

Europa-Park's gardeners have created an imaginative chrysanthemum bed for colourful moments of happiness in Sonnenplatz square. Simply drop by and be amazed!

KRAMERGASSE

The flower bed has a special symbolic meaning: At the centre is the ichthys, the fish, an ancient symbol of the Christian faith. It stands for community, trust and solidarity. In a time full of searching for stability, it gives a sense of hope and confidence. Surrounded by colourful chrysanthemums, a place of contemplation and tranquility is created.

KIRCHSTRASSE

Graceful, long-stemmed cultivars, including new and unique chrysanthemums, are on display here.

ROSENBRUNNEN

Happy Buddha – The figure of the Buddha and the circular shape symbolise harmony, perfection and inner balance. Sitting quietly on the Rosenbrunnen fountain, it invites you to pause for a moment. A gentle mist creates a mystical atmosphere, while colourful chrysanthemums in yellow, orange, red and violet stand for energy, joie de vivre and spiritual depth.

SCHLOSSPLATZ

Here, the national colours of France and Germany merge to create a living symbol of two cultures. A path leads to the swing and invites you to let yourself drift, playfully overcome boundaries and glide back and forth between the countries. The gentle movement brings happiness, lightness and comfort.

STORK TOWER

The butterfly meadow unfolds like a living painting and invites you to immerse yourself in its colourful depths. Delicate butterflies dance above the flowers, while tall grasses sway gently in the wind. Chrysanthemums glow in red, orange and purple, supported by lush green. Selected numbered varieties of chrysanthemums are presented under the shelter of the canopy. These are new plant varieties in the breeding process that will be brought to market next year.

FLORAL OBJECTS

Handcrafted and decorated with hundreds of chrysanthemums, fascinating floral objects await Chrysanthema guests again this year along the circular route and in the city hall gardens. The themes will be switched over half way through the festival. You can see the position of the arrangements in the plan to the right.
